Homes and Lives - Alternatives to Admission

Berkshire Transforming Care Partnership wants to support **children and adults who have a learning disability or autism and behaviour which challenges** to live full, safe and valued lives in their own homes.

The Transforming Care Partnership has members from all the councils in Berkshire and the NHS.

We have supported many people who were in hospital because of their challenging needs to move back home. We have set up an Intensive Support Team to help adults who have a learning disability through difficult times in their lives. Now **we want to provide more support** to people of all ages who have behaviour which challenges so that they can get help earlier, avoid a crisis, and stay out of hospital.



Over the next few months **we will be talking to people who have a learning disability or autism and who have behaviour which can be challenging and their families.**

We will also talk to staff who arrange services and staff who support people. We will look at good services elsewhere. We want to understand what works well and what doesn't work well, and how we could fill the gaps. We will need to work out what this would cost and how to use money differently to provide better services.
